A. Essential Qualification:

1. **Master's Degree with at least 55% marks** (or equivalent grade) in Journalism/Mass Communication/concerned subject from a recognized Indian or foreign university.

2. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the **National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR**, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. degree in accordance with the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;

b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;

c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;

d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;

e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/second

conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Master's Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC.

OR

The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following:

(i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS)

(ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or

(iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

B. Desirable Qualification:

a. Ph.D. in relevant Subject.

b. Minimum three years of teaching/industry experience in the relevant field.

General Terms and Conditions:

Nature of Appointment: Initially for a period of Two Academic Semesters. However, the retention beyond the 1st academic semester shall be subject to satisfactory performance of the candidate.
Selection: As per UGC norms and based on interview performance only.

2. Guest Faculty –Languages

Applications are also invited for guest faculty positions in the following languages: Tamil, Bengali, Hindi, Sanskrit, French, Spanish, and Chinese.

Essential Qualifications:

- Master's Degree in the concerned language with at least 55% marks.
- NET qualified in the relevant subject.
- Preference will be given to candidates with teaching experience.

• Workload: As per requirement

• Remuneration: Rs 1500 per lecture or a maximum of Rs 50,000 per month, according to the University Grants Commission (UGC) guidelines

• Selection: As per UGC norms and based on interview performance only.

Note: The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table3A) for Universities, and Appendix II (Table3B) for Colleges, shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

- 3. All candidates are required to carry their latest CV along with the self-attested copies of certificates at the time of interview.
- 4. No TA/DA will be paid for the interview.
